

- 1953 IISWBM India's first Management Institute was constituted on 25 April by a resolution passed by the Senate of the University of Calcutta, with the then Chief Minister Dr. B.C. Roy as the President and Prof.Dr. D.K. Sanyal as founder Director.
- 1954 The Institute, for the first time in the country, introduced a PG Diploma in Business Management with affiliation of University of Calcutta. Selection of the Institute as a Centre for course in Business Management was made by AICTE.
- 1958 Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru laid the foundation stone of the New Academic Block.
- 1976 MBA programme affiliated to University of Calcutta is introduced.
- 1997 Centre for Research in Materials Management (CRIMM), set up in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Materials Management, Mumbai. CRIMM is first of its kind in Asia-Pacific.
- 2002 MHRM programme affiliated to University of Calcutta is introduced.
- 2003 The Institute celebrated its Golden Jubilee. This year, Government of India released a commemorative stamp on IISWBM to mark 50 years of Management Education in India. National Board of Accreditation (NBA) accredits MBA and PGDBM programmes.
- **2013** The Institute celebrated its Diamond Jubilee by laying the foundation stone of its second state-of- the-art residential campus at Rajarhat, Kolkata.

About the Institute

India's first B-School, Indian Institute of Social Welfare and Business Management (IISWBM), is a name that weighs abundant in legacy. From the choicest alumni bandwagon to the grandeur of the building stature at the educational hub of Kolkata, the institute is stately in ways more than one was constituted on 25 April 1953 by a resolution passed by the Senate of the University of Calcutta. This was the culmination of the joint initiative taken by the University of Calcutta, Government of West Bengal, Government of India and the captains of industry in India to set up for the first time a management education institute in India, a concept alien to many in the educational fraternity at that time. The Institute has successfully crossed its Diamond Jubilee Year, signifying over 66 years of an eventful journey in management education in India. IISWBM was thus established by Dr. B. C. Roy, the then Chief Minister of West Bengal as its Founder-President and Prof. D. K. Sanyal as the founder Director. Government of India, Department of Posts in recognition of 50 years of glorious existence of the first B-school in the country, released a Commemorative Postage Stamp on IISWBM, on 25 April 2004 in New Delhi.

The Institute stands firm on its three pillars: (1) Quality of Faculty, that consistently ranks highest amongst premier B-Schools in terms of Intellectual Capital, (2) Learning environment - the faculty members are dedicated to the development of its students and the Institute and regularly engage themselves in research and project work. Several faculty members have won prestigious award over the years and (3) Alumni's leading across the globe. IISWBM has tested the seasons of time to raise itself as a respectable brandname that generates overwhelming response even today.



Course Overview

The MHRM programme at IISWBM was started in the year 2002. It is a globally accredited 2- year fulltime programme in Human Resource Management. It has been certified by Society of Human Resource Management is at par academically with leading HR programmes run by B- schools. Human Resource Analytics and HR consulting have been introduced as core papers.


Unlike any other general management course, it especially focuses on an advanced learning of the Industrial and Labour laws, Organizational Behaviour, Organizational Development (OD), and Psychoanalytic/Psychometric tools of HRM in order to meet Industry requirements. Role-plays, case-studies, group presentations pertaining to plausible corporate scenario, HR, IR and economically relevant cases make classroom study a myth. Modern audiovisual aids are used to make learning more interactive and appealing to students.

To keep up with the pace of time and demand of the industry and to empower the students, the course has also included SPSS, a software package that helps to analyze and interpret the various aspects of human behavior through statistics and its applications. This is an approach to make HR a quantitative wing of management, rather than a qualitative one. Admissions to the course are based on CAT scores.



Batch Diversity

Out of total strength of 32 students, around 28% students have work experience. 50% students are from engineering, 19% from B.Sc, 16% from B.Com, 6% from BBA, 6% from Arts & 3% from B.Pharm backgrounds. Female candidates account for 53% of the batch.


